WHEREAS, bid openings will be/were held on March 7, 2024,


BE IT ORDAINED by Council for the City of Delphos, Allen and Van Wert Counties, State of Ohio that,

SECTION ONE: The Mayor and/or Safety Service Director is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Fenson Contracting, LLC as the successful bidder for the Pump Station Improvement Project.

SECTION TWO: The cost of said contract is estimated at \$799,713 and shall be appropriated from the Sewer Replacement and Improvement Fund.
